# Overview

**E**CEWS in partnership with Jhpiego is implementing a five-year global project funded by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) on addressing major contributors to maternal mortality and morbidity through the prevention and mitigation of the consequences of Violence Against Women and Girls (VAW/G) and possible drivers of Child Early and Forced Marriage (CEFM).

The project is implemented at the facility and in the community.

At the facility, the project works with 44 health facility across 4 Local Government Areas (LGAs), Afikpo North, Ikwo, Ivo and Ebonyi, while at the community, the project works with 2 LGAs.

## Milestones

A total of

**6,419**

(2,985 males and 3,434 females) community members have been reached on what power is and how to use power in ending gender based violence.

**40**

Adolescents boys and girls, 40 Parents of adolescents and 100 community members has been reached using CVP and ASRH tool kit to promote equality in distributing household chores and equality in raising boys and girls to achieve their life goals and dreams.

**14**

Women savings and loan group has been established and has reached over 280 women with savings and loan opportunities.

An LGA GBV Action Plan has been developed and domesticated in 4 LGAs. The multisectoral taskforce team are currently implementing activities on the action plan:
