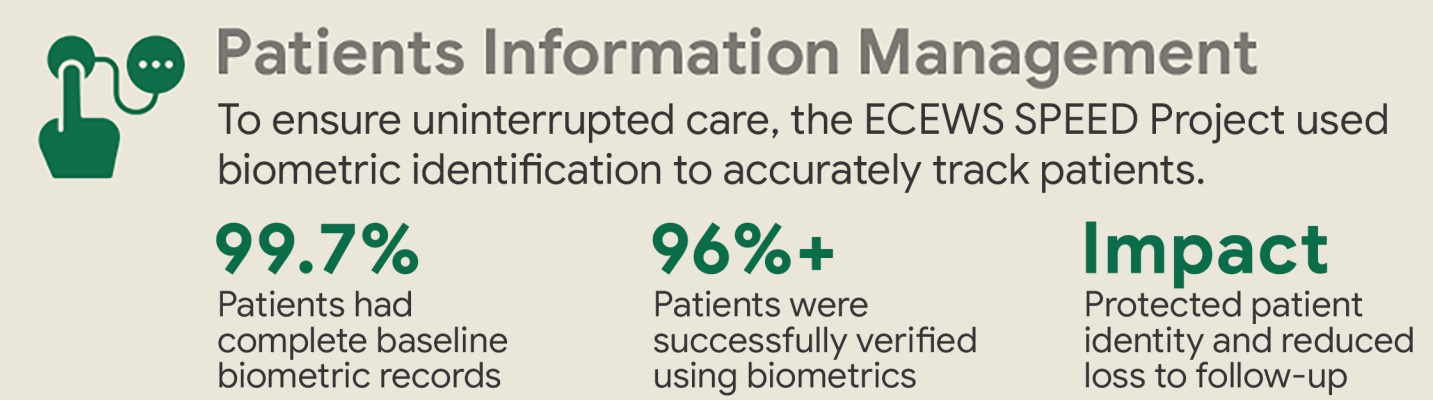
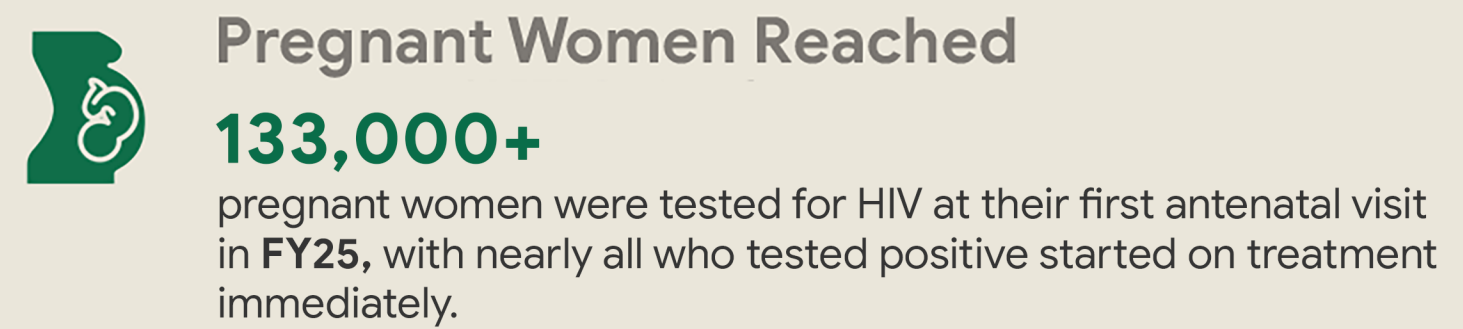
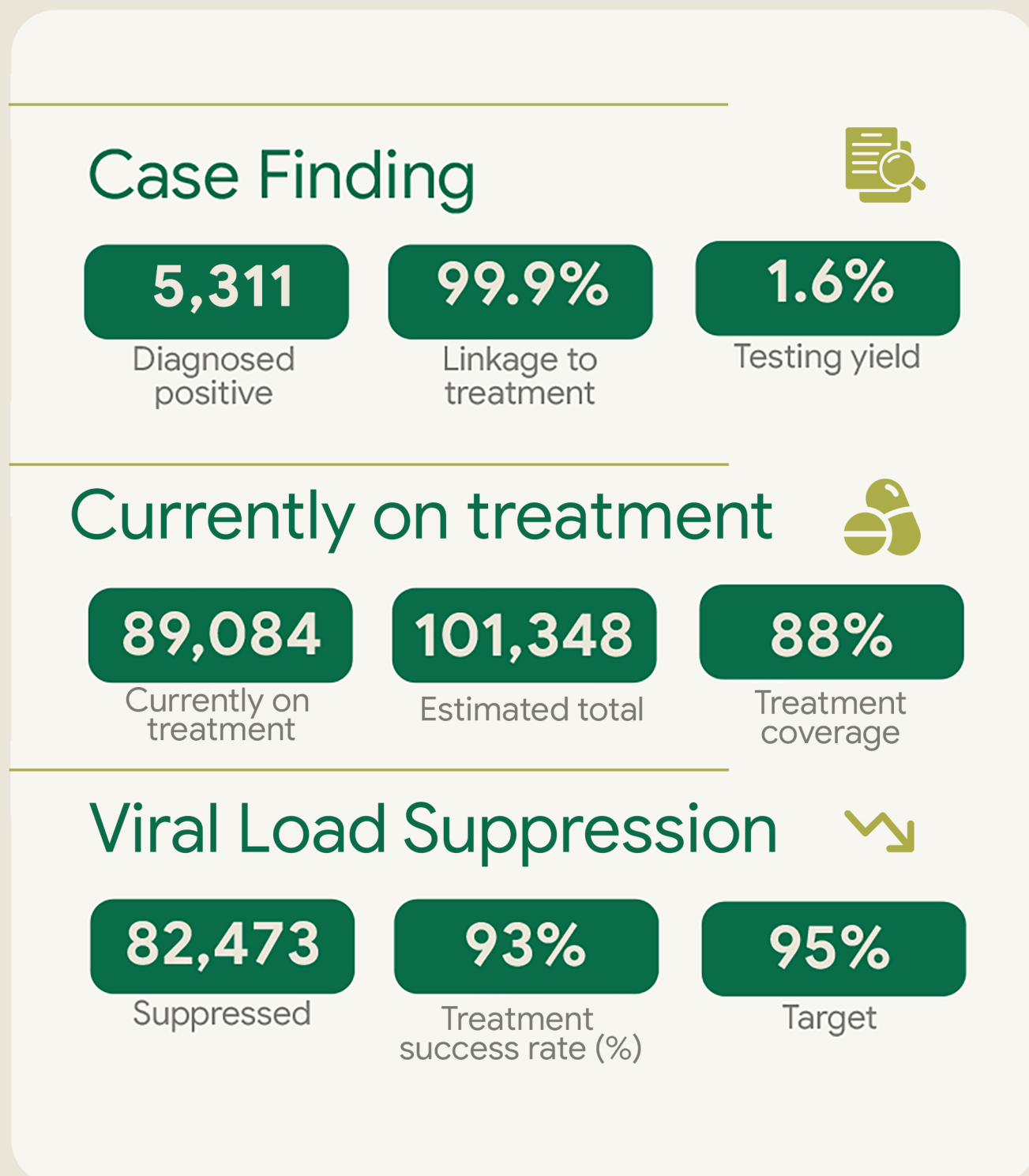
FY25 Achievement Summary

Period: OCT 2024 - SEP. 2025

Excellence Community Educational Welfare Scheme (ECEWS) is implementing a 5-year Sustainable Program for HIV Epidemic Control and Service Delivery (SPEED) Project in Delta, Osun, and Ekiti States in Nigeria.

The SPEED Project is funded by PEPFAR through the United States Centre for Disease Control and Prevention (US-CDC).

Between October 2024 and September 2025, the ECEWS SPEED Project supported about 90,000 women, men, and children across Delta, Osun, and Ekiti States to access life-saving HIV care, with over 9 in 10 people on treatment achieving viral suppression and living healthier, productive lives.



Across Delta, Osun, and Ekiti States, the SPEED Project is helping People living with HIV/AIDs (PLHIV) stay healthy, mothers deliver HIV-free babies, and communities access life-saving services closer to home. In FY25 alone, tens of thousands of people were tested, linked to treatment, and supported to live healthier lives
